MEMORANDUM OPINION

KENNEDY, Judge.

Jose Angel Rodriguez (Defendant) appeals his conviction and sentence for aggravated stalking (violation of a protection order). [RP 160] This Court issued a notice of

proposed summary disposition proposing to affirm, and Defendant has filed a timely memorandum in opposition to the proposed summary affirmance. In his memorandum, Defendant fails to rebut or dispute any of the analysis contained in our notice of proposed summary disposition.
